Rules

2. Competitors are asked to wear correct dress wherever possible and hard hats complying with the BHS 3-point safety regulations must be worn at all times when riding. We strongly recommend you wear hats bearing the code EN13 84 PAS 015 prefix SE1 or ASTN.
3. The competition will be run under British Riding Club rules 2007.
4. The decisions of the judges and/or organisers are final.
5. If there are insufficient entries sections may be amalgamated.
6. Dogs to be kept on leads at all times.

Directions to Bury Farm EC

Head south from Leighton Buzzard on the A4146. (There is a Macdonald's on the corner of the roundabout with the LB by pass and A4146.) As you approach Billington, take first right to Little Billington and Slapton. Follow the road out of Little Billington and just before you reach the sign saying that you have entered the village of Slapton, Bury Farm is on the right hand-side.
