## DRESSAGE CHAMPIONSHIPS 2007

Classes are as follows:-

### PRELIMINARY

#### Preliminary Restricted

For horse and rider combinations who have not competed BD Affiliated Dressage by the date of the championships.

#### Preliminary

For horse and rider combinations who may have gained BD points at novice level only, but not higher. Please note: Horse and Rider combinations are not allowed to enter both the Restricted and Non Restricted Preliminary final.

### NEW for 2007

In the Restricted Preliminary class:-

The best under 14 year old rider also qualifies as long as 58% is achieved. (Under 14 by 1st April 2007). Ponies must not exceed 15hh (153cm).

### NOVICE

#### Novice Restricted

For horse and rider combinations who have not competed BD Affiliated Dressage by the date of the championships.

#### Novice

For horse and rider combinations who may have gained points at novice or elementary but not higher. Please note: Horse and Rider combinations are not allowed to enter both the Restricted and Non Restricted Novice final.

### NEW for 2007

In the Restricted Novice class:-

The best under 14 year old rider also qualifies as long as 58% is achieved. (Under 14 by 1st April 2007). Ponies must not exceed 15hh (153cm).

### LATE RULE

#### CHANGE:

A horse and rider combination that is eligible for the restricted sections of Prelim and Novice cannot compete in any other class but they can compete in both prelim and novice restricted if they qualify for both.

No horse can be ridden by more than one rider on the day.

**Please note:- a minimum of 3 entries per class to be eligible to qualify for the above**

### ELEMENTARY

#### Elementary Open

Open to all.

### MEDIUM

#### Medium Open

Open to all.

1st place in each class qualifies. If there are more than 20 entries in the class, the 2nd placed horse and rider combination also qualifies. **At least 58% must be achieved by all qualifiers.** If the winner has already qualified, the qualification goes down the line to the next best test but that test **must be at least 58%.**

**Please note, it is the horse and rider combination which qualifies.**

**The best Under 14 also qualifies, but they must achieve 58%, and their pony must not exceed 15hh (153cm).**

**Riders must be Chiltern & Thames Rider Members.**

**All riders entering the qualifiers must be Chiltern & Thames Rider Members before competing in the class.**

**Membership costs £7.**

Signed cards need to be sent to The College E.C. Church Road, Keysoe, Beds MK44 2JP once competitors have qualified in all the classes they have aimed for. This must not be later than 1st March 2007 (*except for late qualifiers in March*). **S.A.E's MUST BE INCLUDED FOR RETURN OF CHAMPIONSHIP ENTRY FORM or an email address for receiving the entry form via email.**

**There is a levy of £1 per entry at all qualifying shows payable to Chiltern & Thames Rider.**

**This levy is to pay for administration, publicity, rosettes and prizes at the final.**

The final qualifying show will be 11th March 2007. Finals will take place at the College E.C. on 1st April 2007.

**No substitutions of horse/pony or rider is allowed at the finals.**
